NET PAY:

Deductions:

- Income tax
- National insurance contributions
- Pension contributions
- Contibutions to an employer savings scheme
- Trade Union membership fees



OVERTIME

When workers work overtime they get a higher hourly rate for working extra hours.

SALARY

Salary is expressed in annual terms and paid monthly. Salaries are usually paid to non-manual workers and they are not always paid overtime.
